

2009 RICHARD HOILAND LOCAL CHRISTIAN EDUCATION AWARD

Criteria

Purpose

To give national recognition to an individual who has made a significant contribution to the work of Christian education in a local church or community.

Frequency of Award Presentation

The Richard Hoiland Local Christian Education Award will be presented by National Ministries each biennium. The recipient will receive an engraved plaque and a cash award of \$500.

Requirement

The individual receiving this award must be related to American Baptist Churches USA.

Specific Criteria

Nominees may be lay or professional leaders who have been actively involved in Christian educational ministries in a local church or community for a minimum of five years.

Selection Process

In November 2008, the Recognition and Awards Committee of the Board of National Ministries will review the nominations and select a recipient to recommend to the full Board. Following the vote of the Board, the recipient will be notified. All those making nominations for this award will also receive the name of the chosen recipient. Those nominees not selected will receive a certificate of recognition.
